7.1 HMIS/Coordinated Entry/Built for Zero Update (Standing)

C Freund said PADS stays have been shorter in duration. She also announced their commercial kitchen is up and running now and they have started to serve meals, 5 per week until the kitchen staff are hired. Culinary program is in the works.
